The Developer shall contact or meet with the Client on a mutually acceptable schedule to report all tasks completed, problems encountered, and recommended changes relating to the development of the site. The Developer shall inform the Client promptly by telephone or email upon discovery of any event or problem that may significantly delay the development of the work.

#### 7) Changes

The Client shall be responsible for making additional payments for changes requested that are outside the scope of the original approved quote.

#### 8) Testing and Acceptance

The Developer will make every good-faith effort to thoroughly test all deliverables and make all necessary corrections as a result of such testing prior to handing over the deliverables to the Client. Upon receipt of deliverables, the Client shall both accept the deliverable and make the final payment set forth or provide the Developer with written notice of any corrections to be made and a suggested date for completion, which should be mutually acceptable to both the Developer and the Client.

#### 9) Confidential Information

The Developer acknowledges and agrees that the source materials and technical and marketing plans or other sensitive business information, including all materials containing said information, that are supplied by the Client to the Developer or developed by the Developer in the course of developing the Web site are to be considered confidential if it is originals of the source materials provided by the Developer.

#### 10) Return of Source Information

Upon the Client's acceptance of the final version, or upon the cancellation of the project, the Developer shall provide the Client with all copies and originals of the source materials provided by the Client.

#### 11) Cancellation

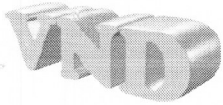
In the event of cancellation of this work, the client will be billed for a prorated amount for the work done; VND will deliver all work done until the cancellation date. If less than 50% of the work was completed upon cancellation, the client will receive a refund of the difference, including all work done to date. The work will be delivered either as a download or in a Media CD, and shall contain all source files, and will be delivered once client's account is fully paid for all dues agreed upon after the cancellation date. Ownership of all copyrights or any original artwork will be transferred to the client after account is paid upon cancellation terms.

#### 14) Unauthorized Use and Program Licenses

The Client will be responsible for payment of any special licensing or royalty fees for software or tools provided by the client to aid in the design process. The Client will indemnify the Developer against all claims and expenses arising from the use of software or artwork for which the Client does not have rights to or authority to use.

#### 15) Warranty of Originality

The Developer warrants and represents that, to the best of his/her knowledge, the work assigned hereunder is original and has not been previously published or that consent to use has been obtained on an unlimited basis; that all work or portions thereof obtained through the undersigned from third parties is original or, if previously published, that consent to use has been obtained on an unlimited basis; that the Developer has full authority to make this agreement; and that the work prepared by the Developer does not contain any scandalous, libelous, or unlawful matter. This warranty does not extend to any uses that the Client or others may make of the Developer's product that may infringe on the rights of others. Client expressly agrees that it will hold the Developer harmless for all liability caused by the Client's use of the Developer's product to the extent such use infringes on the rights of others. Developer guarantees and warrants all work performed, without expiration, under the terms of this agreement 100%. Upon delivery of final work, warranty requests are not billed to the customer and are valid only when Developer corrects items to conform to the original quote or requested work. Any changes made to the original and final delivered work that are NOT made by Developer are NOT guaranteed and requests for changes will be made at the current hourly rate. Any changes or any type of corrections NOT made by the Developer voids the guaranteed work warranty.

#### 16) Limitation of Liability

The time-frame to design, develop and implement a web site can always fluctuate. Client agrees that it shall not hold the Developer or his/her agents or employees liable for any incidental or consequential damages that arise from the Developer's failure to finalize the project in a timely manner.

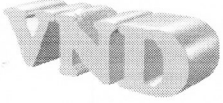
